



## Plesk Cron Instructions


1. Go to **Settings > Scheduled Tasks** (in the **General** group).



2. Select the system user account on whose behalf the task will be executed.



3. Click **Schedule New Task**.



4. Below are screen shots of what the values need to be for each cron job:

## Security/Doba cron job

Command: /usr/bin/php /path/to/cart/root/content/admin/cron/cron.php 5min

## Optional Dollar Days cron job

Task

Enter the value   
in UNIX crontab format, for example 1, 5-7, \*/4

Select the month

Day of the Week \*

Enter the value   
in UNIX crontab format, for example 1, 4-6

Select the day of week

Command \*

The full command is as follows:

```
php /path/to/cart/root/content/admin/admin/plugins/dollar_days_import/cron.php "/path/to/cart/root/"
```

On a Plesk/Parallels Panel based environment /path/to/cart/root/ is generally going to be /var/www/vhosts/yourdomain.tld/httpdocs/ or /var/www/vhosts/yourdomain.tld/httpdocs/cartfolder

5. After you input each cron job, make sure you hit Ok to save the cron job.
